## Mid Term Evaluation

Lutheran World Service India Trust (LWSIT) is a leading not-for-profit non-governmental organization in India. Headquartered at Kolkata the LWSIT has been active in the areas of disaster responses and integrated development for more than a period of four decades. It is currently active in the states of Assam, Odisha, West Bengal and Jharkhand.

The Organisation has decided to undertake a midterm evaluation of LWSIT project intervention under Socio Economic Empowerment for Peace and Reconciliation (SEEPRP) Project for the period 2014 to 2018 is in 2 district of Assam covering 100 communities. The focus of this project is to work for the ethnic and excluded communities<sup>1</sup> who are affected by conflict<sup>2</sup>. The proposal seeks for consultant who has a good understanding of the local context, history of conflict & unrest of the areas (Kokrajhar & chirang district of Assam) and experience of evaluating peace and conflict resolution project.
