LWSIT was registered formally as a National NGO in 2008 thus changing its identity from a country program of LWF/DWS, Geneva to a national organisation in India. LWSIT has inherited a rich legacy of experience by implementing various development projects both in rural and urban areas, humanitarian response and disaster risk reduction projects across India.

The organisation works on the thematic areas of Sustainable Livelihood, Environment Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction, Gender Justice and Peace Building, Education, Health and Organizational Development. The main purpose of LWSIT is to empower disadvantaged communities and it focuses mainly on Odisha, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Assam, while it responds to disaster management in Pan India.

LWSIT celebrated India's 78th Independence Day in all the project areas with the theme "Developed India" addressing the socio-economic challenges through a holistic approach, focusing on proper Education, Healthcare, Gender Justice, Peace building and Sustainable development.

The *GEP Kolkata Unit* organized two days training on climate change adaptation and mitigation. The program was held with 27 women's Self-Help group members from 09 communities.

In GEP Bhubaneswar Unit, Adolescent girls of the Phuleswari-B community were deprived to get all the facilities from the Anganwadi centre, after the intervention of LWSIT & WAVAW members, 14 adolescent girls are now receiving supplementary nutrition, including 1 kg of Puffed rice, 1 kg of Gram & 12 Eggs per month.

In STEER Project Mayurbhanj Unit, Income Generating support of Stationery was provided to 3 Individuals, Garment Business to 1 Woman & Piggery to 5 Women. 154 Families were supported for the Wasteland plantation. 1000 plants of different species were received free of cost from the forest Department, Government of Odisha. 100 Families were supported with 500 Mango & 200 Lemografts.





In STEER Project Bankura Unit, Purnima Besra, SHG member, started fish cultivation and is pouring fish fingerlings in their water source pond for *individual pisciculture program*. This would be a profitable venture for them in 04 months.

50 school students and 20 community members partcipated in the *Skill development Training on DRR*, organised *In STEER Project Kalahandi Unit.* The Junagarh fire office team members demonstrated various skills on fire fighting, rescue measures in emergency.

A training on increasing and strengthening leadership qualities of women was organized *in STEER Project Balangir Unit*, involving 31 female participants with the purpose of knowledge and skills upgradation of the Women on Women empowerment, role and responsibility leadership qualities along with availability of government schemes/opportunities and facilities etc.



A Health checkup camp and medicine support programme were conducted in the EHELL Project of Rayagada & Nabarangpur unit. 373 patients from Rayagada and 574 patients from Nabarangpur were diagonised & treated in the community health centre.

The Children from the **CCI Project, Kolkata** participated in the *International Karate Championship* held in Netaji Indor Stadium Kolkata. Four girls got certificate, while two of them bagged the 1st prize and 3rd prize.

Emergency Response & Relief Distribution

LWSIT distributed 2000 kgs rice and 200 kgs Lentil as relief materials 200 to families whose houses completely were damaged due to flood in Gomati and South Tripura districts. Each of the 200 families were given 10 kgs rice and 1 kg masur dal as relief support. This has reduced their sufferings to some extent and ensured food for one week.

In Manipur, LWSIT conducted 8 Healthcare Support Awareness Programs and 1 Psychosocial support meeting in 3 Districts- Churachandpur (273 IDP), Imphal East (286 IDP) and Kangpokpi (75 IDP). Topics covered In the Healthcare Support were awareness on Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO Act awareness, menstrual hygiene and care for women, awareness on Dengue fever and caring for camp surroundings. Female Hygiene Kits were distributed in the camps.

Resource Mobilisation & Communication



On August 23, LWSIT organized a *Training on Resource Mobilization and Communication* with 23 staff members from Odisha, Assam, Jharkhand, and West Bengal. The training aimed to provide essential skills in mobilizing resources effectively and implementing strategic communication for sustainable organizational objectives.
